3. Objective of the Project

Revised PDO is:

"Assist the Federal Democratic Republic of Ethiopia to eliminate and/or safeguard inventoried publicly-held obsolete pesticide stockpiles and associated waste, and develop a strategy for sustainable management of future accumulations."

- Component A: Obsolete Pesticides Inventory
- Component B: Safeguarding and/or disposal of publicly held obsolete pesticides stocks and associated waste
- Component C: Reduction of Obsolete Pesticide and Associated Waste Re-Accumulation
- Component D: Project Management



Main Milestones Achieved to-date Per Component

Component A: Inventory and Risk Assessment

- □ Completion of Country Project Specific Environmental and Social Assessment (CESA)
 - A consulting firm recruited (QCBS selection procedure)
 - Preliminary, draft and final reports submitted to the WB for approval
- □ Inventory
 - 5 staff trained on a web based FAO- PSMS data base for 10 days by an international trainer recruited by MoA
 - Data collected from 103 stores
 - Data entered and Validated in PSMS
 - Sites prioritized according to risk Safeguarding strategy developed

Future uses of PSMS in Ethiopia

- 1. Manage Pesticide Registration
- □ Data Entry
 - Pesticide Import
 - Pesticide Production/ Formulation
 - Inventory of Existing Stocks
- Movement tracking
 - Generate instructions
 - Record Departure
 - Record an arrival
- 2.Manage Banned ad Restricted Pesticides





Component B: Safeguarding and/or disposal

- □ Bidding document for the disposal contract including supply of equipment for safeguarding of 450 tons and disposal for 300 tons (+/- 20% margin) of identified obsolete pesticide stocks is nearly completed.
- ☐ Disposal of non ASP stocks/ Left over stocks
 - EMP Developed, approved by WB and publicly disclosed
 - Voluntary Contribution Agreement was signed (between CLI and MoA)
 - Safeguarding of stocks (rusted drums),
 - 395 tons shipped to the UK by VEOLIA UK





Component C: Reduction of Obsolete Pesticide and Associated Waste ReAccumulation

1. Construction of Pesticide Store

- Budget reallocated (USD 310,000),
- Store design and tender document are ready
- Environmental and Social Impact Assessment (ESIA)
 for the construction of a pesticide store in Addis Ababa
 has been prepared and is awaiting for approval and
 disclosure,
- Approval obtained for the recruitment of construction supervisor



Component C: Continued ...

- 2. Army Worm Control Strategy and Pesticide Use Monitoring
- A strategy document developed and validated
- Training workshop on armyworm control conducted



Component C: Continued...

3. Awareness raising

- Communication Strategy Developed
- TV and Radio Messages developed
- Print out reach materials (posters, calendars and leaflets) are under development
- Proclamation No. 674/2010 distributed, awareness workshop conducted
- Different awareness raising training work shops conducted





Component D: Project Mgt, M&E

- □ Work planning Periodically updated
- □ Financial Management
 - Timely withdrawal application
 - Timely FMRs to the donor (WB)
 - Current disbursement is 24%
- □ Audit (External and Internal)
- □ Reporting (M &E)
 - Timely progress reports to the donor as per the grant agreement
 - Periodic reports to MoA & EPA
- □ Project Restructuring
 - Signed on July 29/2011
 - Current closing date is December 31/2012



6. Shortage of Funds

Funding gap for Disposal

- ☐ The current fund is only sufficient for safeguarding of 450 tons and disposal 300 tons of obsolete pesticides
- ☐ In collaboration with the WB, trying to secure fund for the disposal of 150 tons (500,000 USD)
- ☐ Still no fund for safeguarding and disposal of associate waste (2.5 million USD) excluding remediation of contaminated soil
- ☐ Prevention to be continued by PRRP Ethiopia
