- Joint Meeting of Pesticide Residues
- Body of the World Health Organisation (WHO) and Food and Agricultural Organisation (FOA)
- Goal: evaluation of world-wide used pesticides to enhance food safety worldwide

# Codex alimentarius & CCPR



- Codex alimentarius: global reference point for consumers, food producers and processors, national food control agencies and the international food trade.
- CCPR: Codex committee on Pesticide Residues; yearly meeting to discuss the MRL proposals from JMPR
- Codex MRL (CXL) is a value taking into account all world-wide uses of a certain pesticide on a certain crop (worst-case will determine MRL).
- No legal basis in EU although in EU most countries Food Safety Authorities will respect Codex MRLs

- Plant Protection product Regulation (EC) 1107/2009
- Rapporteur member state evaluates dossier
- Peer review/expert meetings
- EFSA conclusion with list of end points http://www.efsa.europa.eu/en/publications.htm
- Eurpean Commission decision on (non)approval

#### MRL Regulation (EC) 396/2005

- Rapporteur member state evaluates dossier
- EFSA advices on food safety/MRL value
- European Commission adopt MRLs (or not) http://ec.europa.eu/sanco\_pesticides/public





## OECD

- Organisation of Economic Co-operation and Development
- Proposing standards worldwide, e.g. in pesticide evaluation
- Guidelines for performing studies
